Cardiovascular Disorders in Hemodialysis, edited by Claudio Ronco, and Alessandra Brendolan, and Nathan W. Levin. Basel: S. Karger, 2005. ISBN 3-8055-7938-1. This 363-page hardbound text further continues the long tradition of the Contributions to Nephrology series, edited by Claudio Ronco. ISSN: 0302-5144. Volume 149 of this series is divided into 11 sections, with specific topics ranging from technology perspectives, dialysis principles and technology, lessons from international trials, dialysis schedules and techniques, vascular access management, dry weight assessment, biological markers in dialysis, cardiovascular risks and inflammation, cardiovascular and mineral disorders, new techniques, and future trends. Each of the 37 chapters is preceded by a brief abstract and each includes tables, figures, and a list of references. Finally, the text includes both an author and subject index. The cost of this text is 228.00 CHF, 163.00 Euro, and \$207.25 US.
