ROBINSON, Introduction to Model Theory and the Metamathematics of Algebra, North-Holland, 1974, 284 pp. One of the great masters of logic in this century bequeathed us a heritage of ideas and techniques which will be with us a long time, and which promise to revolutionize mathematics. Required reading.
